Reading Readiness

Phonics: Letter and sound review of previous alphabets: Ll, Oo, Gg, Hh, Tt, Pp, Aa, Nn, and Mm.

Introduce the next set of letters and sounds: li, Ss, Ff, Rr, Kk, Bb, Uu, Zz, Cc, and Ee.

Sight Words: Review of the following: Formally introduced word: ***The, the, A, a, end***

New set of words: ***to, of, from, four, into, one, you, said, have, do, love,***

Sounding out Words:

Review of our Saxon Reader Words: Booklet # 1 ***log, hop, hot, got, A, a, pop, an, tan, tap, Pal*** and Booklet #2 ***on, mop, mat, Tom, Pam, mom***

Introduce next set of Booklets (#3 through #9) and their word list.

Booklet #3 ***pig, pigs, has, sit, sits, stop, to, his, plop, as, Stan's, and Stan.***

Booklet #4 ***Frog, ran, off, top, on, hill, still, fast, last,***

Booklet #5 ***big, trip, in, fill, fills, it, tips, Babs, Bam, Bill, Bob***

Booklet #6 ***is, must, run, lag, not, bug, fun, zip, zap***

Booklet #7 ***big, help, Gram, sets, up, cups, get, gets, mess, him, net, set, pals, Ben, Ben's***

Booklet #8 ***did, dog, red, bed, one, dad, had, tell, best***

Booklet #9 ***jet, jump, jumps, into, do, hen, grass, splat, mud, cat, stand, van, tan, get***

Math Readiness

Review of sorting, classifying, patterning,

Calendar Activities: Days of the Week, recognizing the words in a variety of print.

Number recognition, ordinal number, counting on, tallying, and place value, grouping in units of 2, 5, and 10.

Counting from 0-100 and to identify 1-100 Skip count by 2s, 5s, & 10s (maybe more!!)

Writing numerals correctly 1-20

Learning math facts, 0-5 then 6-10 and the exploration of missing addends.

Science

Developing observation skills in simple investigations and record some data.

Seasonal changes, animals and the habitats, liquids and solids forms of matter.

Social Studies

Learning addresses and important phone numbers.

Develop an understanding the world around them.
